



Public Works Full Time Heavy Equipment Operator Job Opportunity

The Town of South Bruce Peninsula's Public Works Department is accepting applications for a Full Time Heavy Equipment Operator. Applicants must submit a resume and cover letter outlining their qualifications for the position.

The Full Time Heavy Equipment Operator will be responsible for operating heavy equipment in various capacities throughout the Town.

Between June 15 to Labour Day, the regular work week will be Friday to Tuesday, and the main duties will be to operate equipment to cover, compact, conduct general site grading at the landfill site. This position supports and backfills for the Landfill Site Attendant in opening and closing the site, collecting tipping fees, and maintaining recycling and diversion areas.

Between Labour Day and October 31 and between April 1 and June 14, the regular work week will be Monday to Friday, and the main duties of the position will be to operate equipment to cover, compact, conduct general site grading at the landfill site, as well as operate all heavy equipment and provides manual labour to maintain roadways, sidewalks, sanitary sewers, storm sewers, water mains and other Town-owned structures and facilities.

Between November 1 and March 31, the regular work week will be Saturday to Wednesday, and the main duties of the position will be to provide day-time winter patrol, calling out snow plow crews, as necessary, occasionally operating a snow plow providing winter maintenance, and operating equipment to cover, compact, conduct general site grading at the landfill site.

Hours of work will be a minimum of 80 hours over a two-week period. Start and stopping times may vary during the season of the year or as necessary to fulfil the Employer's obligation in providing approved service levels and seasonal maintenance.

Applicants must possess a valid Class D/Z license. Experience, knowledge, and training related to all aspects of Public Works employee responsibilities, and basic landfill operation, is preferred. Experience operating a plow truck is an asset. The successful applicant will be required to provide a clear criminal record check and clean driving abstract.
