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Dear Resident,

Many homeowners are unaware that they are responsible for the repairs to water service and sewer/septic lines on their private property.

Service line failures on private property, including leaks, blockages, and breaks, can be unexpected and costly for homeowners. Basic homeowner's insurance may not cover the costs associated with these repairs. When service line failures are not promptly and professionally addressed, they can lead to water loss and wastewater pollution in our Town.

The Town of South Bruce Peninsula has entered into a commercial agreement with Service Line Warranties of Canada (SLWC),* an independent company that introduces an optional low-cost repair plan program for homeowners. The Town has authorized the use of its logo to assure homeowners of the program's legitimacy.

The enclosed letter from the program provider, SLWC, can help you decide whether their repair plan program is right for you. Participation in the program is optional and voluntary.

Homeowners are also encouraged to check with their insurance provider before enrolling.

For all program enquiries, including SLWC program communication, enrollment, coverage, and repairs, please contact SLWC directly as per the enclosed letter.

Coverage also includes the septic line, from the external wall of your home up to the point of connection to the septic tank on your property.



Septic tanks and leaching fields are not covered.

What is covered?

Water and Sewer/Septic Line **Breaks Can Happen Anytime.**

Reminder Letter: Please ignore if you have already enrolled.

Dear Homeowner,

Like many homeowners, you may not be aware that you are responsible for repairs to the exterior water service and sewer/septic lines from the town property line to your home. Breakdowns to exterior lines can happen anytime. Water and sewer/septic lines are subject to freezing, sediments, tree roots, and corrosion. In the case of a blockage, leak, or break to these lines, it would be up to the homeowner to find a qualified plumber and get the lines repaired—a service line replacement can be expensive (see back page).

The Town of South Bruce Peninsula has endorsed Service Line Warranties of Canada (SLWC),* an independent company that helps eligible homeowners be prepared in the case of such an emergency (refer to the letter from the Town of South Bruce Peninsula).

Starting for as low as \$4.58+HST per month, with optional service line repair plans from SLWC, you get:

- 1. Up to \$5,000 per call for covered water service or well line repairs and up to \$8,000 per call for covered sewer/ septic line repairs, which includes the repair or replacement of non-functioning grinder pumps (both plans include a 30-day wait period with a money-back guarantee)
- 2. Multiple service calls annually
- 3. Access to a 24/7, 365-days-a-year emergency service hotline to schedule a repair
- 4. Covered repairs performed by local, licensed, and insured plumbers

In the event of an emergency, SLWC will take care of your covered repair, dispatching a qualified plumber to your home and paying the bill directly—so you pay nothing for covered repairs up to the benefit amount. These plans can save you a significant amount of money and the hassle of finding a qualified plumber, which can be difficult in the best of times, let alone in an emergency.

Enroll in both water and sewer/septic line plans to receive a 10% discount on your first year** of monthly fees.
