Important Message to Everyone in the Town of South Bruce Peninsula

As the Fire Chief for the Town of South Bruce Peninsula, I declare a total fire ban for all of the Town of South Bruce Peninsula.

This fire ban is made under By-Law 17-2013, Being a By-Law to Regulate Open Air Burning in the Town of South Bruce Peninsula.

This is a total fire ban – no fires are permitted in South Bruce Peninsula.

We have established a fire ban hot line-if anyone is aware of people burning during this fire ban, please call 226-668-3925.

Not respecting a municipal fire ban can have important consequences.

Every person who sets a fire during a fire ban is guilty of an offence and will receive a fine of \$300.

If a false report about a fire is made, the Town can charge for the cost of the Fire Department response.
