



## Public Notice

### **Town of South Bruce Peninsula Water and Sewage Works Study Former Township of Amabel and Former Village of Hepworth Addendum Process No. 3**

The Town of South Bruce Peninsula has commissioned a review of options presented in Addendum No. 2 - REVISED to the previously completed Water and Sewage Works Environmental Study Report (ESR) for the Sauble Beach and Hepworth areas.

The preferred wastewater servicing option, as recommended in Addendum No. 2 - REVISED, will be reviewed under a new Addendum No. 3 process.

Addendum No. 2 - REVISED recommended sewer servicing for only the Development Control Area (DCA) of Sauble Beach. The proposed wastewater treatment plant location for this preferred option is east of Sauble Beach at the north end of Municipal Road (Part Lot 28, Concession C) near the Sauble River.

Alternative wastewater servicing options will be examined under the Addendum No. 3 process, including:

- Review sewer service area
- Review wastewater treatment plant locations
- Review wastewater treatment process
- Review effluent discharge locations

This notice also serves as an invitation to the community and other interested parties to attend a Public Meeting scheduled for:

The Public Meeting will provide an opportunity for residents to learn more about the potential wastewater options and to provide comment regarding the Addendum No.3 process. Representatives of the Consultant (Genivar Consultants LP) and the Town of South Bruce Peninsula will be on hand to answer questions. The format for both sessions will be the same.

Any revisions to the Environmental Study Report (ESR) will be carried out in accordance with the Municipal Engineers Association *Municipal Class Environmental Assessment* document. Following consideration of technical, economic, environmental and social issues, as well as public consultation, Addendum No. 3 to the ESR Report will be prepared and made available for public review.
