

Significant Interest in Grey-Bruce COVID-19 community update – revised instructions to connect

TIVERTON, ON – *Wednesday, March 18, 2020* – Since the announcement of a community Town Hall for a COVID-19 update from health officials there has been significant interest from across the Region. Additionally, Canada is experiencing significant strain on telecommunications systems due to heavier use.
