## **Notice of Public Open House**

### **Municipal Class Environmental Assessment for Upgrading the Warton Wastewater Treatment Plant**

The Town of South Bruce Peninsula has initiated a Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (Class EA) to evaluate alternatives to upgrade the Warton Wastewater Treatment Plant (WWTP) from its current capacity of 2,500 cubic metres per day to a future capacity of 4,000 cubic metres per day.

The study is being conducted in accordance with **Schedule C** of the **Municipal Class Environmental Assessment** process (October 2000, amended 2007 and 2011), which is approved under the Ontario Environmental Assessment Act. A Public Open House is planned to update the public on the draft recommended upgrades and to receive input and comments from interested persons.

**Thursday, March 5, 2015** from 4:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. in the upstairs of the Warton Arena, located at 526 Taylor Street, Warton.
