### Claude St. and Brown St. Reconstruction Town of Warton

#### Claude St. and Brown St. Reconstruction

The Town of South Bruce Peninsula has entered into a contract with R.J. Burnside & Associates Limited (Consulting Professional Engineers) for the reconstruction of Brown and Claude Streets from Mary Street to William Street in the Town of Warton. The work generally consists of the replacement of storm and sanitary sewers and services, watermain and water services, sidewalk, curb and gutter, etc. The road will also be improved through changes in road base materials, asphalt and possibly vertical alignment.

Field work such as topographic and legal surveys, geotechnical investigations, underground utility locates and other work necessary for the design of the works is expected to start on August 6, 2013 and be completed by September 3, 2013.

R.J. Burnside & Associates Limited and its sub-consultants will be on-site performing many of the above noted tasks within the Town Right-of-Way and except for some non-invasive topographic survey work is not expected to encroach onto private property.

#### Will I Have Access to My Home or Business?

R.J. Burnside & Associates Limited and its Sub-Consultants are required to conduct the work in a safe manner, including delineation, if required, of the work area, etc. We ask that you take extra caution during the geotechnical investigation phase of the works as a drilling machine will be drilling for soil samples and one lane of traffic may be affected. The Geotechnical Sub-consultant will provide safety and traffic control measures to ensure everyone's safety.
