Municipal Class Environmental Assessment for Upgrading / Expanding the Wiarton Wastewater Treatment Plant

The Town of South Bruce Peninsula has initiated a Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (Class EA) to evaluate alternatives to potentially expand the Wiarton Wastewater Treatment Plant (WWTP) from its current capacity of 2500 cubic metre per day to a future capacity of 4000 cubic metre per day.

The study is being conducted in accordance with **Schedule C** of the **Municipal Class Environmental Assessment** process (October 2000, amended 2007 and 2011), which is approved under the Ontario Environmental Assessment Act. A Public Open House is planned to provide further information to the public and to receive input and comments from interested persons.
